"Three slaves to be sold and let by public auction"...

"On Monday the 18<sup>th</sup> of May, 1829, under the trees, for sale, the three following slaves;

Hannibal, about 80 years old, an excellent house servant, of good character

William, about 35 years old, a laborer

Nancy, an excellent house servant & nurse"
