### Docent # 8 – Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr.

***United States Postal Service Stamp  
1968***

This 15-cent stamp was issued by the United States Postal Service to commemorate Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. and his importance to the Civil Rights Movement. This stamp is part of a larger collection called the Black Heritage Series produced by The Postal Service.

***Tin Tray***

This tin tray features a lithograph of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. surrounded by the text "I have a dream" & "Freedom for all my people". On the back of the tray is text from the eulogy of Dr. MLK Jr. with the following words:

"If I can do my duty as a Christian ought. If I can bring salvation to a world once wrought. If I can spread the message as the Master taught, then my living will not have been in vain"
